

Speak Up Week of Action, Terms And Conditions Of Use

Welcome to the Speak Up Week Of Action Map. This tool (hereby known as the 'Online Map') is provided by The Climate Coalition (TCC) and its member organisations. By using the Online Map, you are agreeing to the following terms of use.

Users' Personal Details

TCC or its member organisations may place a "cookie" on the browser of your computer in order to improve their services. This enables them to allow users to register on the Online Map. These cookies can be switched off on your computer if you so wish although this will restrict the functionality of the Online Map.

As part of the process for registering on the Online Map, you are asked to provide data including your name, email address, and location. You will be additionally asked to optionally provide your phone number if you are participating in events, or mandatorily provide your phone number if you are organising an event. This data is stored by TCC for coordination purposes and is only shared with member organisations via which the supporter has signed up. In Scotland, activity is coordinated by TCC's sister coalition Stop Climate Chaos Scotland (SCCS), and those who sign up to the map in Scotland will be contacted by SCCS instead of TCC.

By submitting your data you are agreeing to receive updates from TCC (or SCCS) and be contacted by your local event organiser, Speak Up Regional Mobiliser or organisational representatives involved in planning the campaign about the Speak Up Week of Action in July 2017. Your local event organiser will not have direct access to your email address.

If, during the registration process, if you opt to receive updates from TCC or from the organisation whose website you signed up through, they may send you e-mails about other organisational activities which may not be related to the Speak Up Week of Action. You can unsubscribe from these communications at any time through links included in each mail. TCC or its member organisations will not share, sell or trade addresses with any other companies or member organisations under any circumstances.

Please remember that any information you upload to the Online Map enters the public domain. TCC or its member organisations cannot be held responsible for the misuse of any personal information that you disclose in your posts.

You may be contacted by email or telephone by a Speak Up Regional Mobiliser to support local coordination. Local organisers may also be put in touch with other local organisers in their area by the Regional Mobiliser.

Participants may also be contacted by local organisers, but this will be via the Online Map. Your email address will not be shared with local organisers.

You will only be contacted by the organisation via which you signed up, unless you also opted in to contact from TCC (or SCCS).

TCC or its member organisations will not disclose your personal information without your consent, except as described in this privacy policy or as required by law, court order or as requested by other government or law enforcement authority.

Content

Unless otherwise indicated, all content such as text, graphics, logos, images, audio clips, video clips, digital downloads and data compilations, is the property of TCC or its member organisations, and is protected by copyright law. Content may be changed at any time.

The Online Map may offer links to external websites with the aim of improving your experience but TCC or its member organisations do not formally approve or endorse these websites and are not responsible for their content or privacy practices.

TCC or its member organisations do not guarantee the accuracy or completeness of any information or content, nor its fitness for any particular purpose. In some instances, the information provided may represent opinion and judgement. Under no circumstances will TCC or its member organisations be liable for any loss or damage caused by reliance on the content of the Online Map.

By using the Online Map, you assume all risks associated with its use, including any risk to your computer, software or data being damaged by any virus, software, or any other file which might be transmitted or activated via this website.

User-Generated Content

You are responsible for all activities that occur under your account or password.

You must not use any part of the Online Map to post or upload content which is illegal, immoral, offensive to TCC, its member organisations or others, or in breach of others' rights.
